Dear Parents, 'ישי'

We hope all is going well and that your children are having a productive and healthy summer. As we prepare for the coming school year, now is the time to place your order for the Cheder sweatshirts. Attached please find the Cheder Sweatshirt Order Form. Please place your orders no later than September 3rd, the first day of school, by sending in/delivering the attached order form and cash, check or credit card information.

As you are shopping for new clothing, please be mindful of the Cheder uniform policies. Please read the information below regarding the school uniform for the Boys' and Girls' Schools.

Boys' School

- Boys must wear a *talis katan* and yarmulke at all times. No knitted or leather yarmulkes allowed. No non-Jewish writing allowed, including sports logos
- Students must wear navy blue or black pants (no jeans or oversized-cargo pockets)
- A button down shirt (white, blue or light blue with white stripes. No t-shirts or polo shirts)
- Only the Cheder sweater may be worn in the Cheder building
- No sandals, Crocs, open back shoes or heelies allowed
- Uniform for boys who have reached Bar Mitzvah age:
 - a. White shirts
 - b. Plain dark blue or black yarmulka without any writing or designs
 - c. Dark colored shoes without any light or any bright colored designs or soles
 - d. Must come to Cheder every day with a hat and a dark colored suit jacket or blazer for *davening* and *bentching*, even when not *davening* in Cheder. Zippered jackets or sport jackets are not acceptable

<u>Girls School</u>

Our school uniform includes a plaid jumper/skirt or navy blue pleated skirt or jumper, choice of hunter green or white button-down blouse (Oxford Shirt must have *Tznius* Button) or hunter green or white, long-sleeved polo with a collar and the school uniform sweater.

- Skirt must be mid-calf, long enough to cover the knees at all times. Only navy blue, black, white, brown or grey tights (no socks) may be worn in grades Pre 1A 8. The Cheder will not provide a change of tights!
- Earrings: Earrings should be close to the ear. No costume jewelry, no hoops, and no dangling earrings
- Make-up, nail polish, and accessories (necklaces, scarves, etc.) are not allowed at any time. If a child comes to school with nail polish, Parents will be called to bring nail polish remover
- Hair below the shoulder must be tied back in a pony tail or braid
- Shoes: Only refined colored and style school shoes may be worn. No strappy sandals and no sneakers or high tops are allowed. Rain boots may NEVER be worn in school!
