Dear Parents,

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This year we have adopted an exciting curriculum known as להבין ולהשכיל. This program has been developed with a very clear step by step approach to enable your child to learn חומש independently.

What is להבין ולהשכיל: It is a skills-based curriculum where the students begin in the first grade starting with הכנה program even before intensive חומש learning begins. The brainchild of the Consortium of Jewish Day School, it was designed with the intention of ensuring that students are gaining the textual skills to learn חומש independently.

The multifaceted program comes with:

- * Extensive workbooks for the students and intensive teachers' guides for the Morah.
- * Creative lessons and beautiful worksheets target different modalities, so they are ideal for differentiation and stress varied skills.
- * Interactive songs, beautiful charts and posters, and flashcards for students.
- * Formative and summative assessments throughout the year enable teachers to track the progress of the students and those skills which need to be strengthened.
- * Ability to track the students' progress throughout the grade level and the school, since it ensures consistency of required skills across the board.

The curriculum is a spiraling curriculum, constantly reviewing the skills from the previous year, and adding more skills as the grades progress.


We will be using this curriculum in grades 1, 2, and 3 with the intention to go onto Grade 4 next year . אי"ה.

Tzivos Hashem is an incentive program to encourage children to grow in Yiddishkeit. The program is geared for girls and boys in Pre-1a through 6th grades. The program includes a weekly checklist, magazine, and a monthly rally with medals and prizes. As your children complete more items on the checklist they will move up in rank.

By registering for this program, you as a parent commit to helping your children complete their weekly mission sheets.

Tzivos Hashem has eased the task for parents to review the mission sheet with their children, by creating a mobile friendly website. Now with the swipe of your finger you can easily check off what your children have done that week. To access the mobile version of their website visitwww.mashpia.com/mobile.

All children who sign up this year will receive their very own Tzivos Hashem Pushka.

If this is your first time creating a Tzivos Hashem account follow the steps below:

Step 1:

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Go to ww.Mashpia.com and sign in.

- A. Click on "Create a Parent Account"
- B. Click "Add Children to Account"

C. Enter your child's unique 20 digit barcode. To obtain this number email: <u>TzivosHashem@chedermonsey.org</u>. If your child is new to the school please include in the email your child's name, which school and grade he was in.

Step 2.

Click "Child Management". Then Click "Register Children"

Step 3.

Under the Enroll section, Click the box next to "I would like to enroll this child in the Tzivos Hashem 5775 program. (\$50, Early bird special \$40/\$45)".

Under the terms section, Click the box next to "I will support my children in completing their missions,"

Click "Continue" on the bottom right corner.

Step 4.

Enter in your credit card information and click "Continue" Congratulations! Your child is now enrolled in Tzivos Hashem. This account will give you the ability to:

- 1. Print and mark your child's missions
- 2. Track your child's progress
- 3. Sign up for weekly emails of their progress

Every Friday morning, each class will have a designated time slot to visit the library and check out books. Library in the girls' school will start next Friday, September 23.

In order for the library to function efficiently, we need the children to understand the value of the books and take responsibility for the ones they borrow. This is a great opportunity to teach them to respect the property of others.

To this end, we are asking that a parent sign the permission slip at the bottom of this letter, indicating that they have read the letter and allow their child to use the library. One permission slip per family (for the girls building) is adequate. As soon as the school librarian receives the signed form, your child/ren will be able to use the library.

The library has been growing steadily over the years and now has a sizeable collection of books. Book sponsorships are always welcome and really help boost our inventory, particularly of newly released books. The cost is \$20. Many parents choose to sponsor a book in honor of a child's birthday or other occasion. The child will choose a book, check it out the first week, and receive a prize. The book will be clearly labeled with a dedication sticker announcing the sponsor and occasion.
