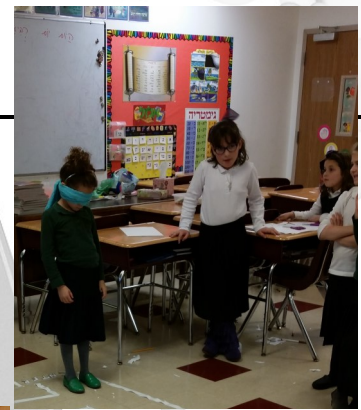

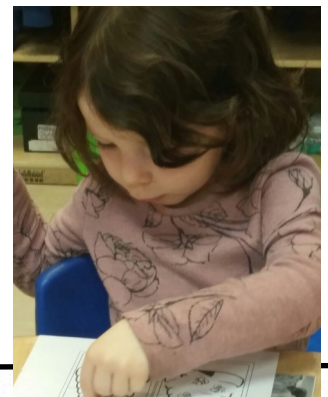


Preschool NEWS
