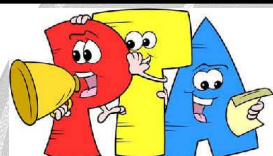

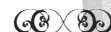

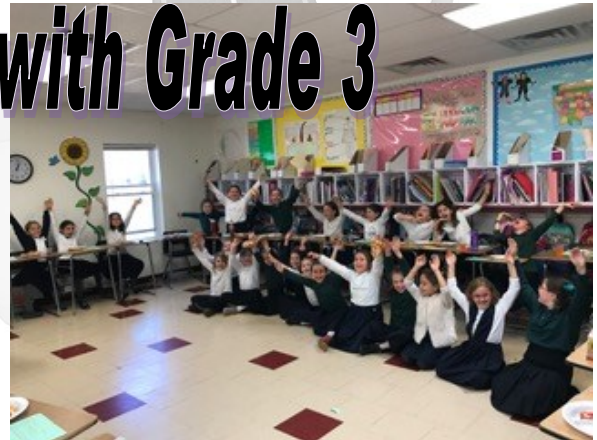

Preschool!

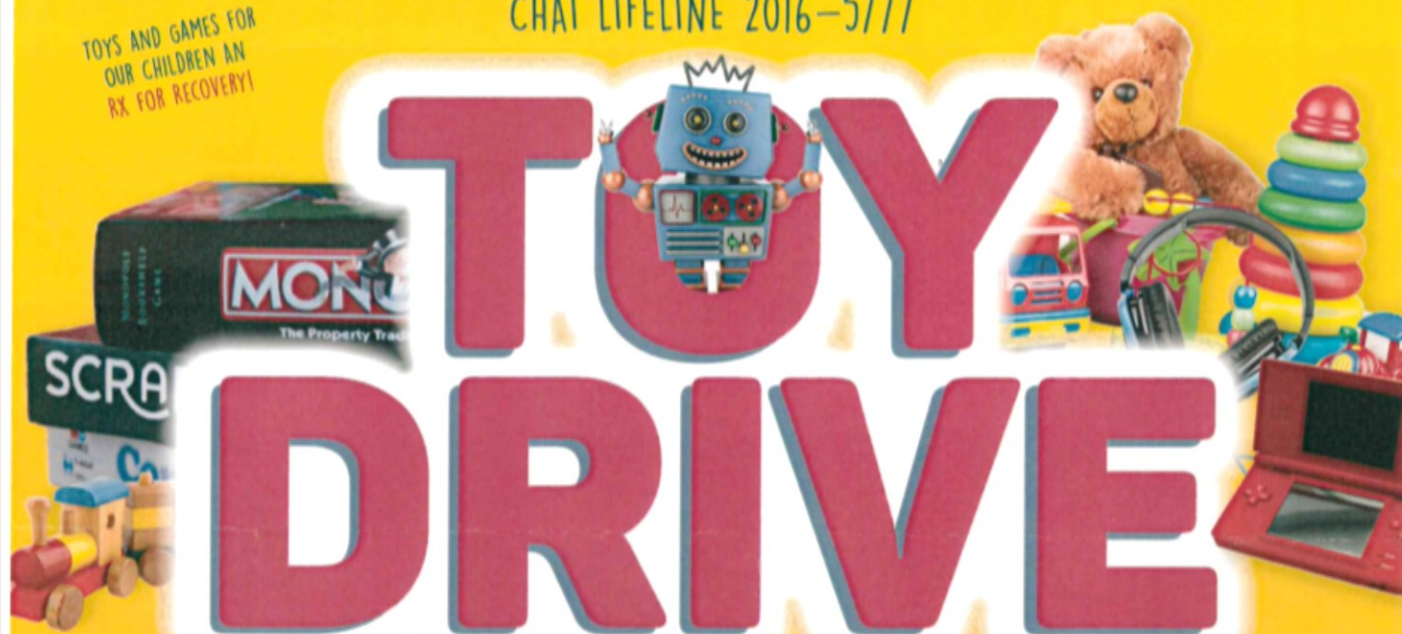

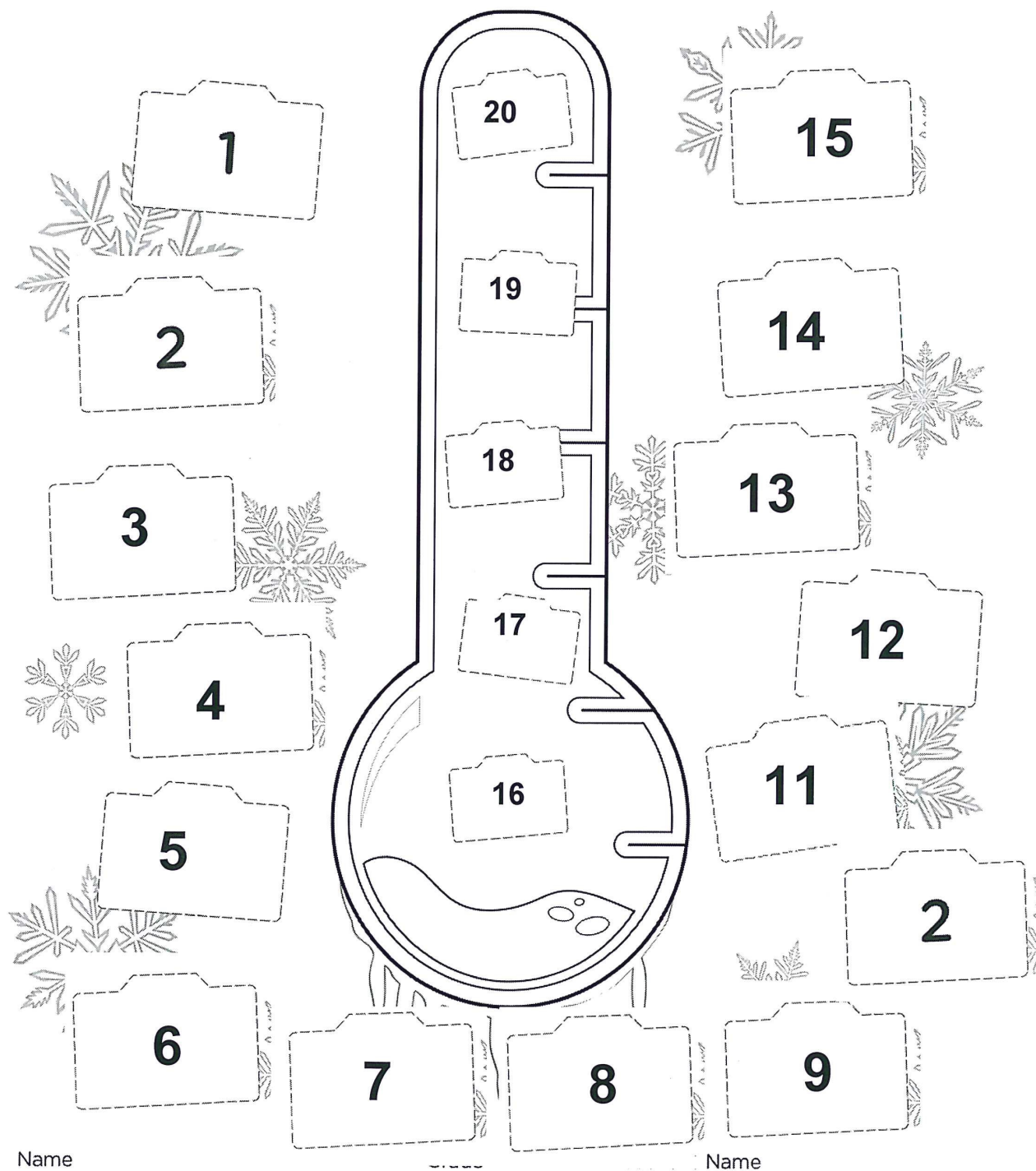
