

It is my goal to raise the level of learning and achievements of our girls. I hope with continued work together with our teachers we will make great strides this year.

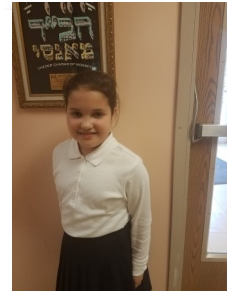
