Tell us about something you miss from your old place? I miss my old neighbor, but I still keep up with her.



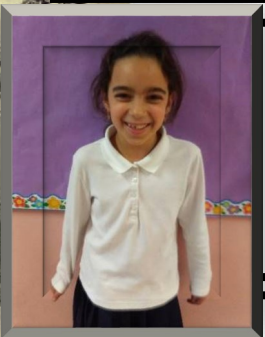
Chanale Gluckowsky - Grade 3

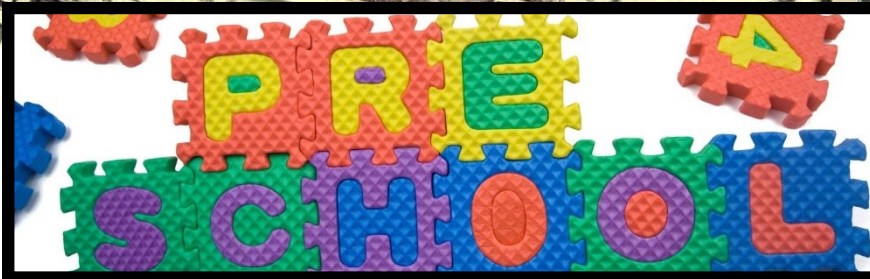

Science with Morah Michal:

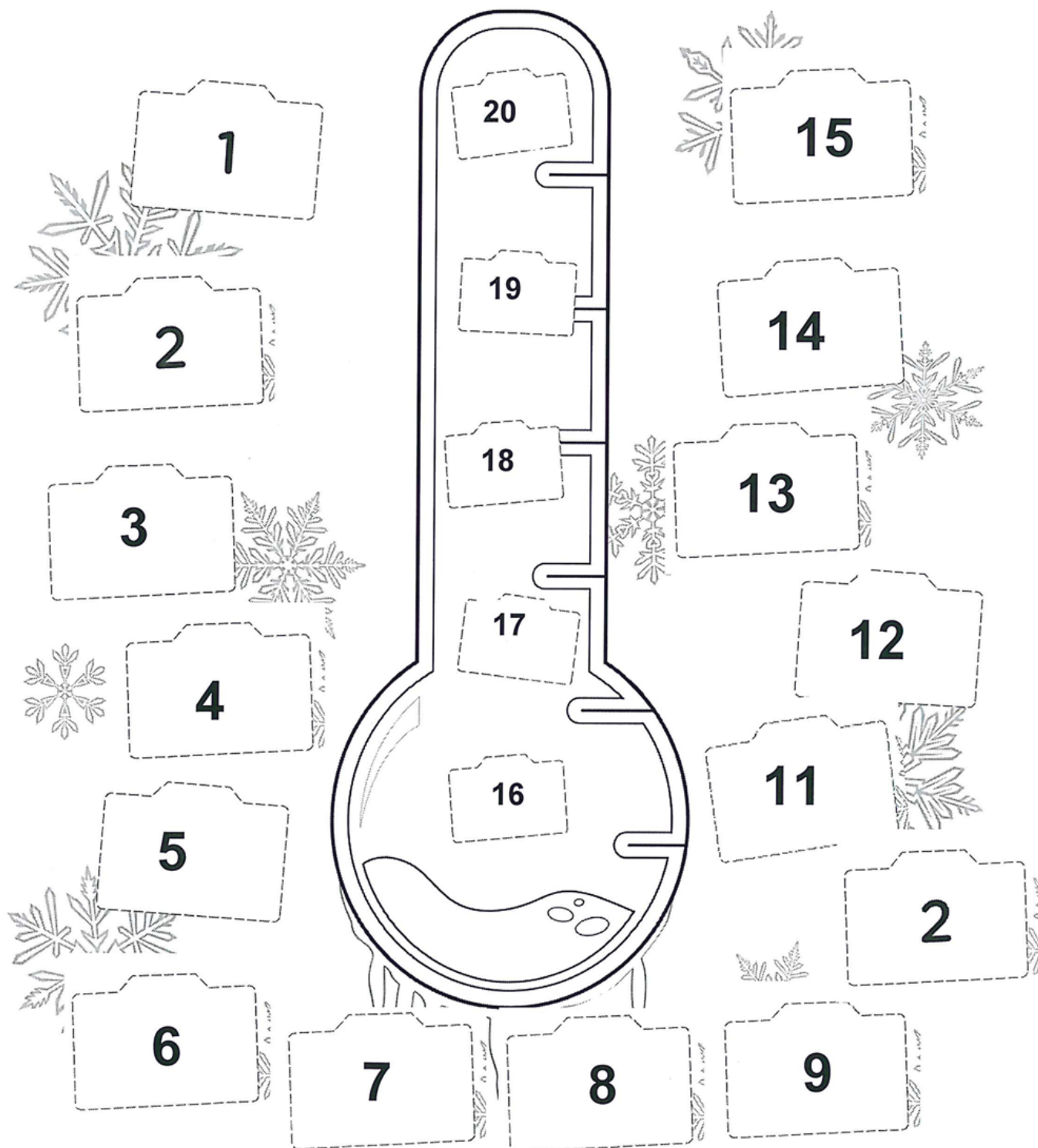
