The cheder is a proud partner of the International Chidon Mitzvos. Cheder-talmidim have successfully competed as finalists at various tiers of the Chidon bringing nachas to their parents and the entire cheder community.

Our commitment to learning the mitzvos is rooted in the Rebbe's request that we learn the entire Torah at the level of our ability, in preparation for the coming of Moshiach. The Rebbe often explained that learning Rambam should be in addition to the scheduled studies of talmidei hayeshivos.

With this in mind, for the coming year, participation in the Chidon will depend on students successful participation in day to day learning and proper conduct at cheder. Talmidim are required to maintain an above 80% average in all subjects (kodesh and chol), and a B and above in behavior and overall conduct.
