This Shabbos we read parshas Ki Seitsei, the Torah speaks about going to war. On occasion we hear people say that we should shleter our children from war that we should protect them from hearing about the evils of war. For people with this perspective, war itself is an evil and the world would do much better without it.

Chassidus teaches us that war is positive and a necessary part of our life. We are constantly at war within ourselves. As educators, we are given the responsibility to raise soldiers who are ready for their daily mission. Children are in the Army of Hashem, older students are in battle as the Rebbe Rashab explained in the sicha entitled כל היוצא למלחמת בית דוד.

Our children need to be empowered and strengthened. The Rebbe's mandate to conquer the world through Torah is our mandate. Our children, the ones who will bring Moshiach, should stand proud, tall and strong in the face of all adversaries, those from within and without.

Sending your children to cheder is premised on the faith that Hashem runs the world and that our sole mission in life is to serve Hashem. May we see the fruits of our efforts in our children owning our faith, tradition and practice with a wholehearted embrace, Ready to fight and WIN!
The revelation of Moshiach will bring about the end of war as we know it. As declared by the Rambam in his closing words of sefer Yad Hachazakoh. May this happen now.
