



A PEEK AT OUR WEEK



Welcome back to this year's first edition of "A Peek At Our Week". Our boys returned to school eager to learn and are off to a great start! Read further for a sampling of what has been going on in our classrooms.

Mrs. Mandel's first graders started this week off with 'my number book' and math vocabulary words such as addition sentence and sum. Working hands on with connecting cubes, each boy got his own set of cubes and explored different ways to add. In reading, the class worked on many literacy skills such as letter and sound recognition and well as spelling. As the class learned new letters the boys noted that the letters were found in many of their names. The boys enjoyed sharing words related to the new sounds of the day and had a chance to come up and spell words on the classroom pocket chart.

Mrs. Eckstein's third graders are aiming to have a wonderful year as each talmid reaches for the stars! This week was the first full week of English. The boys are eager to learn and are b"H adjusting to once again being in a classroom all day. In math they reviewed place value and learned how to read numbers through the 100 millions! They also began to learn how to round numbers to the nearest 10 and the nearest 100. The class began this year's social studies curriculum, which includes map skills and learning different aspects relating to communities. They began learning paragraph writing, current events (News on the Run), and had their first spelling test! The class also did a passage in the reader about rabbits (ask your son what a 'passage' is). A message from Mrs. Eckstein: I have reached out to all the parents and if I have not spoken to you, please check your phones for my message. I am looking forward to working together with you to bring out the best in each child. Please feel free to reach out to me by leaving a message on my home phone or with the secretary.

In Mrs. Volfman's third grade, English studies have been in full swing. In math the boys have been learning about even and odd numbers, rounding numbers as well as adding and subtracting with multiple digits. In their ELA class the class has been focusing on the skill of how to ask questions and then find key details to answer the questions from the text. The boys have been hard at work learning new vocabulary and spelling words. They also learned all about story elements and enjoyed using their interactive reading notebooks to learn this concept.

Need to create a new child account?


Click "Add Child", then "My Child is not in a Base" and select "Cheder Chabad Monsey" as their Base (school).




