A PEEK AT OUR WEEK

What a fun week our first graders had! A special clay making activity was enjoyed by all as the boys helped out with measuring, pouring, adding ingredients, coloring and kneading the clay mixture, and dividing it for the class. Everyone helped out in so many different ways! It was beautiful to see the class collaboration! Math class was hands on with math connecting cubes and counters. The boys built cube towers of equal amounts and divided the towers to show many different addition sentences. In ELA, the boys are making great strides in letter formation, sentence structure, compound words, vowel differentiation, and so much more.

Mrs. Nadav's class worked hard on their doubles facts this week. The boys came up with some pretty funny hints to help remember them. The 9s got into a fight, the 8s ate way too much and the 7s had so many Shabbos guests at their table! The class has been working on verbs, and the boys came up with some great ones this week. Each day they chose a verb and wrote a sentence about it in their writing notebooks. In honor of Rosh Chodesh Kislev, the boys made some special treats. They each melted chocolate by placing a cup inside another cup with hot water. Once the chocolate melted, they dipped in pretzel sticks and put on toppings. YUM! The class is getting very close to the 1000 points they need to earn for their special prize. It looks like they may just get there this coming week.

Miss Klatzko's class had a great week! Congratulations second grade on completing Chapter 2 in math. The class had a review on Thursday and took the exam on Monday. The boys did an excellent job and proved that they have a handle on the material. They are moving on to Chapter 3 which focuses on basic facts and relationships in numbers. The boys enjoyed a fun introduction using candy to demonstrate using previous knowledge to solve new types of problems. The class's vocabulary is getting better and better as they move from chapter to chapter. The boys know the words well and are able to do the vocabulary worksheets independently. We are so proud of them. They have been practicing their reading and improving each day. Each chapter focuses on a specific rule or skill and the corresponding workbook reinforces the material.

This week the third grade was treated to a STEM class with Dr. Shnitzel! The boys were so excited to participate in experiments involving the explosive powers of Baking soda, Vinegar and, believe it or not, Alka Seltzer!! Mrs. Volfman's class continued to learn their multiplication facts and strategies to help with the computations. In spelling they learned another set of homophones. The boys have begun to work on their animal research projects, where they are exploring, learning, and writing about different characteristics of an animal of their choice. In ELA this week the class worked on the skill of questioning key details in a story. B"H it has been a week of growth and learning in third grade.

Mrs. Eckstein's third graders are winding down their review of subtraction with borrowing. There will be a test this coming Tuesday b"H. Please check your son's knapsack for the review sheets that were sent home on Thursday. The class also began a new unit in Math this week...telling time! Everyone in the class thought this part of the review would be soooo easy...and then it became quite challenging as Mrs. Eckstein introduced the concept of 'elapsed time'. In reading the boys learned a story called "The Wolf in Sheep's Clothing". It is one of Aesop's fables, and Mrs. Eckstein explained who Aesop was and what a fable is. The boys did a really professional job on doing the writing assignment about the story. They were also very excited to begin learning Cursive! Finally, to wind up the week, the boys began learning a unit in science about the five Senses and enjoyed a lively discussion on current events.

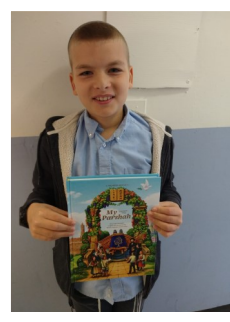
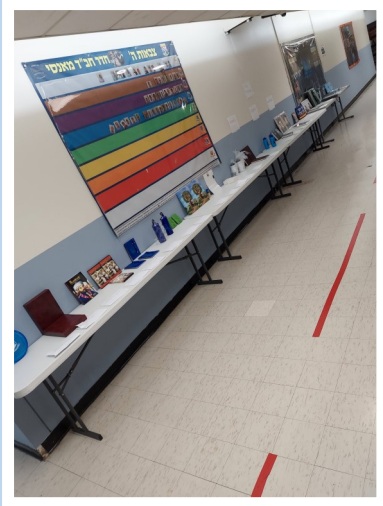
