LETTER FROM THE MENAHEL:

Dear Parents,

Going to the Ohel to mark the yahrtzeit of the Frierdiker Rebbe is a horo'oh of the Rebbe which each of us fulfil as part of our connection to the Rebbe. However, our joint efforts can enhance the fulfilment of this instruction making it more impactful for our children.

At the cheder, talmidim learn about writing a pan, about hiskashrus as well as hear stories of the Rebbeim. Parents can augment these discussions in many ways. Here is one way in which you could be the appreciation of the physical body of a Yid. We go to the Ohel, the resting place of the holy body of the Rebbeim, although their neshamah transcends the body, throughout their lifetime and especially now. Nevertheless, the body of a Yid which can fulfill mitzvos is of primary importance.

As parents, our partnership in bringing a Yid into this world is primarily to bring their physical body into this world. The goal of our *chinuch* is to highlight the infinite opportunity of this world in doing *mitzvos* which can only be performed with a *quf qashmi*.

A PEEK AT OUR WEEK

We are excited to announce the engagement of our second grade teacher, Miss Klatzko. Wishing her and her chosson a mazel tov from the entire Cheder family!

Mrs. Mandel's first graders learned how to use abbreviations this week with words like- USA, OK, and more. They further discovered many words with final double consonants (like buzz and odd) and ck (like quack and lock). In math the boys recorded related facts. The boys then chose 3 numbers, wrote 1 addition fact, and found 3 more related facts. They were so excited to pass their mid chapter checkpoint! The boys worked on their map skills this week in an amazing hands on activity called "me on the map" in which students learned about their location on the globe: the continent, country, state, city street, and school building. They looked at maps of the USA, world maps, and the globe.

Our second and third graders had an inspiring lesson with Dr. Shnitzel on how to create a homemade filter. Dr. Schnitzel explained that there are many places throughout the world where, unfortunately, people do not have access to clean water. He taught the boys how to filter muddy, smelly water. As he the water was not boiled after the filtration process, neither Mrs. Eckstein, nor Mrs. Volfman volunteered to drink the water!

Mrs. Eckstein's class learned about another community helper, the Policeman. In writing, they wrote about how policemen help keep us safe. The whole class enjoyed the skit on the story Stone Soup that was presented by Alexander Gaerman, Mendel Keller, Dovber Lizpitz, Yitzchak Kass, and Dovid Yedidyah Elisha. In addition, on Thursday the boys began presenting their posters on one of the 5 senses. Most of the work was done on school-time, so no sheets were sent home. Finally, the class read a story about the invention of the potato chip! Stay tuned for the next unit...inventors and inventions! A note from Mrs. Eckstein: Please review multiplication with your son every night. While we review, it is difficult for your son to progress without having that knowledge at his finger-tips. It takes a few minutes of practice every night. There will be a test on 1x-5x tables on Tuesday iy"H.

Mrs. Volfman's class continued working on figuring out elapsed time in math this week. They began Their unit on inventions and read the story of how potato chips were invented in their ELA book. The boys then had an opportunity to explore different inventors and their inventions by reading books about different inventors. In social studies the class discussed their next community helper - policemen. They discussed safety rules and extended that idea into their writing this week.
