A PEEK AT OUR WEEK

Mrs. Mandel's first graders read a beautiful poem with a profound lesson about not speaking loshon hora. They enjoyed decorating their poem page to create a beautiful project to remind them about this middah. In math, a spider web model helped the class count by tens and find nine ways to reach the sum of ninety. Using a skills foundation of ones and tens, the boys did pre-Pesach themed math examples. In language arts the boys are well versed in their spelling rules. Using VCCV (vowel consonant consonant vowel) helps them divide words for reading in their individualized reading groups.

Mrs. Hermann's second graders have been working on subtracting two and three digit numbers with regrouping and began a new reader this week. They are progressing nicely in both subjects. The boys enjoyed making Seder pillows, as well. They decorated and stuffed their pillows and created beautiful and useful projects that will iy'H be used for many years to come.

The boys are getting more and more excited as we approach the wonderful yomtov of Pesach! To give them an opportunity to expend some energy in a fun and educational way, Mrs. Eckstein's class began math on Monday with a round of KABOOM. The class was divided into groups of two, and the boys took turns asking each other math questions. Some cards with the word KABOOM were interspersed among the question cards. Ask your son what happened when they got a KABBOOM card....On Tuesday during writing, the boys had to complete a Pesach story. Everyone enjoyed hearing the various endings that their friends had made up. In social studies the boys learned about different customs all around the world. They discussed different Pesach customs and different family customs as well. The boys all received multiplication and division flashcards. Please have them review while on vacation so that they don't forget what they worked so hard to attain. In addition, handwriting books will be sent home as review work.
