A PEEK AT OUR WEEK

On Monday the third through 8th graders will be having the NYS Math test. Please make sure to send in number two pencils and be sure that your sons get a good night rest on Sunday night.

The first graders are excited about their new show and tell program. The program will be running daily. The boys can't wait to see what each boy brings in. Our math wizards are racing through their work on representing data using graphs. This week the class worked in pairs to write and decode words that had 'r' controlled syllables. All groups showed exemplary collaboration.

Once again, this past Monday the first and third graders had a wonderful STEM class with Dr. Shnitzel. He explained how the idea of solar power developed, as he showed the boys electric powered items, then battery operated items and, finally, the wave of the future, solar power! Most of the boys have heard of TESLA cars and tried to demonstrate to Dr Shnitzel how much they know about solar energy. Speaking of science, Mrs. Eckstein's students have begun to see their terrariums sprout! They are very excited and have been updating Mrs Eckstein as to their plants progress. Stay tuned for more! In math, the third graders are really forging ahead with developing and practicing new skills. While fractions are really a form of division, learning fractions is fun! On Wednesday, the boys practiced measuring different amounts using measuring cups and colorful sand. Next week they hope to further our math skills by measuring the ingredients for sweet treats! In reading, the class ended off the unit on biographies with a story about the life of Louis Braille. Mrs. Eckstein discussed with the boys how Louis did not give up, but rather used his disability to help others. Mrs. Eckstein passed around a card with braille dots on it for all to see. Finally, the third grade has been assigned their first book report (due the Thursday after Shavuot, May 27th).

The seventh graders learned a story called 'Home on the Range' in which the theme of family loyalty was depicted in a humorous manner. They also had their first test on the other stories they have learned. By now the boys are progressing nicely. Mrs Eckstein always tries to insert some sort of Hashkafic message into what the class is learning. By doing this, they are using an English subject to grow as Yidden. Next week the boys will be assigned a short book report. By doing this they will be able to work on their reading and writing skills simultaneously. Have a

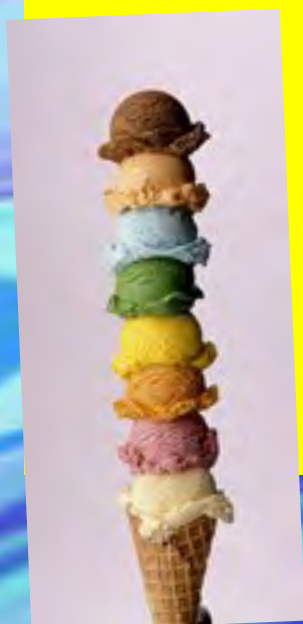
