Letter from the Menahel:

Dear Parents,

This week the cheder marked Zayin Cheshvan with a discussion about Inclusion. During the time of the Beis Hamikdosh the Yidden living in Eretz Yisrael waited with davening for rain until those living farthest from Yerusholayim got home. This teaches us means to accommodated and include even those living far away or with other limitations.

I spoke to the talmidim about the meaning of inclusion and how it applies in their lives. They should first look out and try to recognize what barriers may keep a friend or sibling from participating in a certain activity and then help modify the activity to enable them to join. The modification is best when it applies to everyone and often helps everyone.

An example I shared with the talmidim regarded the printing of the Vilna Shas on off-white paper to allow Yidden who get headaches from bright white paper to learn *gemoro* for many hours comfortably.

Please encourage your children to identify areas where they can accommodate others and keep the idea of inclusion in their minds at all times. Although I used the word accommodation, the correct approach isn't to make a special accommodation, rather to position things in such a way that they respect the dignity of every neshamah equally from the start and remove artificial barriers for all.

Talmidim are already learning about the Rebbe Rashab and learning about the importance of his nesius for us, talmidim of Tomchei Temimim, as he is the Rebbe who founded the paradigm of our Yeshivah where we learn nigleh and chassidus.

May the zechus of our learning about our Rabbeim add to the Yiras Shomayim and chassidishkeit of our talmidim.
