# A PEEK AT OUR WEEK

This week Grade 3 finished their math chapter where we learned about all different types of graphs. We are very excited to begin to learn multiplication next week iyH. In ELA this week we spent a lot of time comparing and contrasting texts.

# Chanukah Tzedakah Campaign

Dear Parents שיחיו,

One of the central minhagim of Chanukah is to increase in giving Tzedakah.

Once again, we are asking Cheder talmidim, with your permission and supervision, to participate in our Chanukah Pushkah Campaign to help raise funds for learning-centered programs at the Cheder.

Chanukah is the Festival of Light and Torah is called light, Torah ohr. The funds of this campaign will go towards providing extra support and incentives to improve students' learning.

Every talmid will receive a personalized Cheder pushkah and will be given the opportunity to collect tzedakah. Talmidim may collect tzedakah from neighbors on the block, or people they meet in their local shuls or at community celebrations, etc. Talmidim may also donate part of their maaser for their chanukah gelt.

The cheder is offering incentives to encourage participation. We have put together a catalog of prizes which talmidim can earn per amount of money they raise. These prizes are not a raffle, prizes are given per qualifying amount collected to every student. Samples of the prizes will be on display at the cheder office.

The deadline for submitting pushkahs and ordering from the catalog is Friday, 6 Teves, 5782.

We ask that you encourage your son/s to participate in this project in a way that raises the pride of our talmidim in the cheder and have them learn responsibility and integrity.
