## LETTER FROM THE MENAHEL:

Dear parents,

The meaning of the name of this week's *Parshah, Bo*, is come. Often times, when the *posuk* states that *Hashem* told Moshe to go to Pharaoh, it says *lech*, go to Pharaoh.

*Rashi* addresses this question by saying that *Hashem* said to Moshe come with Me, I will join you in going to Pharaoh.

This week we will celebrate *Yud Shevat*, in the first *sicha* that the *Rebbe* said as a *Rebbe*, on *Yud Shevat*, 5751, after reciting the *mairer Basi Legani*, the *Rebbe* said to the *chasidim* who were present that every *chossid* who was given a *shlichus* by the *Frierdiker Rebbe* should continue fulfilling that *shlichus*. Then the *Rebbe* added the same message of this week's *parshah*, the *Rebbe* will help us and support us in our *shlichus*, the *Rebbe* is coming along.

In the area of *chinuch*, we are all here to assist our children in developing themselves, not in doing their work for them.

It may be easier to carry your child than to walk slowly with them, to give your child the answers to their homework or to learn the entire *chumash*, *mishnayos* or *gemoro* with them, rather than to help them recall what they learned on their own. The balance that is asked of us isn't easy. As parents, we walk a fine line between encouraging and taxing, over and under supporting. We daven that *Hashem* guides us to apply just the right amount of support that our children use as much of their own *koichos* as realistically possible.

Thank you to the PTA for their Rosh Chodesh gift to the Rebbies, teachers and staff, ushering in the Fruit-themed month of Shevat.

# A PEEK AT OUR WEEK

This week Dr. Schnitzel introduced the second grade class to the word 'Chemistry'. We learned what happens when things are combined and observed their reactions.

We learned about the Long U-E which is the sound of the letter U. (Same as the name) as in tube, prune and tune. In our reader, we read about the Smith family, staying over in a nearby motel due to a sudden storm. The room was small so they made do and were "snug as a bug in a rug". The boys chuckled upon hearing this idiom. Our new math tool for use in addition was drawing Arrays/Equal groups to find the sum. Three rows of five is  $5+5+5=15$ . Lesson Five in spelling focused on Short U words as in truck. Added to all this, "News On the Run". We are surely Second to None!!

In third grade we are continuing to become multiplication experts. This week we continued learning our multiplication facts in many fun interactive ways. In our writing unit we learned different strategies to use when writing rhyming poems. In reading we read a few stories together and focused on the skill of understanding the characterization of the story. We ended our week with an amazing Dr. Shnitzel show!

Class 4B is really moving along in Math at a rapid pace! We have reviewed ALL the multiplication tables through  $12x$ . Mrs. Eckstein expects the boys to know their math backwards as well as forwards! There was a Math Test this week on Multiplication and Division, including remainders and algebraic equations. Most of the boys really outdid themselves! We have now continued on to "Long" Multiplication and Division. The boys have shown they have a keen understanding of the material, even if they sometimes make computational errors. In Reading we have begun a unit on interesting inventions. This week we learned about Velcro! In Social Studies we completed the Immigrant Report presentations and learned about the 3 levels of Government, as well as the reason for the system of 'checks and balances'. In Writing, the boys wrote about a trip back in time, and anyone who wanted to, read his story to the class. Some boys went back to Mitzrayim, others to the Holocaust; one boy went back in time simply to 2021! They did beautiful work! Thank you, Mrs. Riesenberg for the knock-hockey! It really enhances our recess! Have continued Nachas!

In the fifth grade in geography we learned about parallels of latitude and meridians of longitude. We learned how to locate a state based on its coordinates. We compared the map of colonial times to the current map of the United States. What progress we are making in social studies! The class is learning about the causes of the American revolution and we are heading to do a project on the three branches of Government. We are having a math test on Monday on eight functions in fractions. Please go over these skills with your son. A sheet was sent home. Have a great Shabbos.

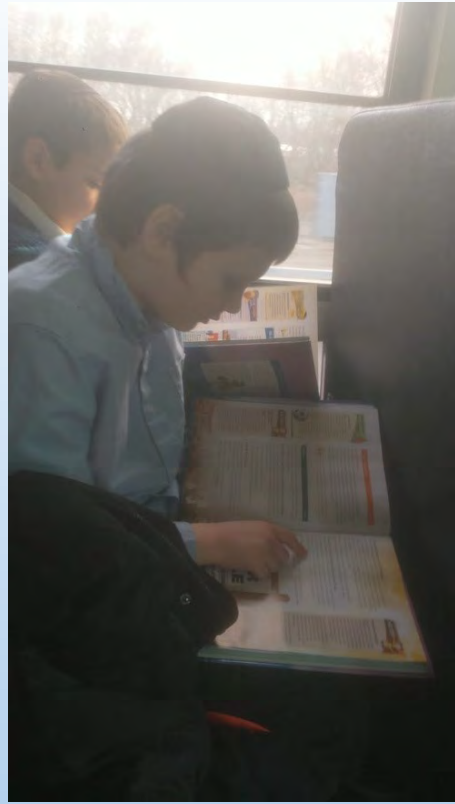

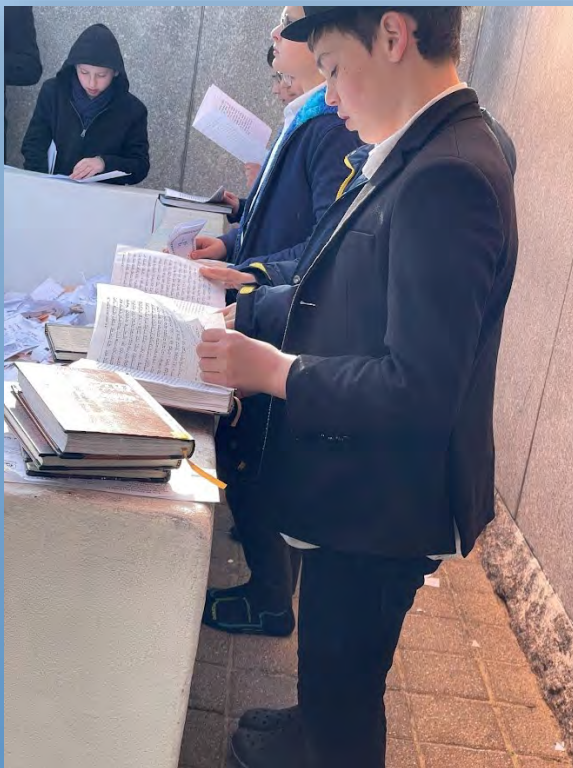
