A PEEK AT OUR WEEK

Second grade has mastered their reading skills for midpoint of the year. They were tested orally, one on one. We are so proud of their efforts and success!! The boys did well on a math test too. Look out for their scores (in their folder). Each boy received his very own notebook in which he will be writing a daily entry. A special Mazal Tov shout out to our very own Rabbi Silverstein!! Loads of nachas from baby Menachem Mendel.

Students in grade 3 learned so much this week in English studies. In math we focused on the associative and distributive property of multiplication and how to use it when figuring out a multiplication equation. We also learned how to multiply with factors 7 and 8. In writing we continued to write poems about the topic of snow and wrote a story titled "The Snowman Who Opened His Eyes". We continued in our vocabulary chapter and played a bingo game to reinforce the meaning of the words. We also started a unit on homophones. We had fun trying to differentiate and use the correct word in sentences. In our reading unit this week we continued to read stories that depict a character's good middos and strength to go out of their way for another person. One of the stories we read this week was an old story called "Mindy Gets Her Reward". Looking forward to another great week!

Do you know that Dead Monkeys Smell Bad? The boys in 4B know that...and more! They use this memory mnemonic to help them remember how to do 'Long Division'...Divide, Multiply, Subtract and Bring down. They are also picking up "Long Multiplication" skills at the same time. In Science we have continued learning about the Solar System, and in Social Studies we are still learning about the three levels of government. We have also progressed in our Wordly Wise vocabulary books; Mrs. Eckstein 'raised the bar' by adding a few spelling words to our weekly vocabulary test. In Writing we had to write a story using descriptive language and connecting sentences; they make us sound so intelligent! In addition, this week, Mrs. Eckstein had a mystery for us to solve. She read us a story by our favorite fiction author, Mrs. Millman, and asked us if the story sounded familiar. Mrs. Millman had written a story about OUR CLASS that appeared in last week's Binyan magazine! The week was topped off by our favorite STEM teacher, Dr. Schnitzel! PLEASE NOTE: There is another Math test this coming week iy"H on Multiplication and Division.

Congratulations to the entire fifth grade on the completion of their writings on the topic "A Gift I Would Like to Receive." The writings will be compiled into a booklet and each child will get his own copy. We took a cumulative math test on many fraction skills. We are ready to start adding with fractions. In social studies we are reading about the birth certificate of the United States- the Declaration of Independence. We are learning about what caused the colonists to rebel and the different battles that were fought. Have a good Shabbos.




