# A PEEK AT OUR WEEK

Second grade boys were introduced to the next vowel team EA, as in leaf. We wrote sentences and drew pictures with many EA words. Our math unit has us climbing mountains. Finding the sum of three addends and four addends too. The boys followed the same rules of regrouping, with ease, no matter the height of the equation. In the spirit of Mazal Adar Dagim, each boy "fished" for a nice message to write to a classmate. "The more the merrier." *Gutten chodesh!!*

This week in Grade 3 we began to learn division. We started with learning division rules for 0, 1, 2 and dividing by the same number. We did different fun activities to understand these concepts. In our reading unit, we read an interesting article all about water cities. In writing we began a unit on narrative writing. The boys are enjoying writing narrative stories about themselves. We ended our week with an amazing Dr. Shnitzel show where we learned all about the center of gravity.

In class 4B one feels the simcha of Adar in the air simply by watching the smiles lighting up the Talmidim's faces along with their daily rendition of Purim niggunim. We have been continuing to advance in Math and Vocabulary. In Reading this week, the boys learned how to find answers to questions and cite the source from the story. We read an adorable "play" about the way animals view humans. We learned about theme, settings and characters. In Social Studies we have completed the unit on the Southwest and hope to begin the unit on the Southeast next. And we have finally completed the unit on the Solar System! The boys rounded off the unit with a project (see pictures) and will be presenting reports on what they have learned iy"H after Purim (information will be sent home Monday iy"H). Our next topic will be shorter but equally as interesting...nutrition! To round off the week and *Iekovod* Rosh Chodesh Adar Bais, the writing assignment was on a very amusing topic! What was it? Ask your son. Have a guten Chodesh and Gut Shabbos!

We continue to review all our math skills in fifth grade from the beginning of the year, and in addition learned a new skill - multiplying fractions. The fifth grade read a story in their readers, an historical fiction, that gave insight into what it means to be a slave during the American Revolution. Pronouns and nouns. We are careful to have the verb in agreement with the noun or pronoun focusing on the correct usage. We are using our ELA books to brush up on our reading comprehension skills. Although Purim is in the air, we try to stay focused on our learning.- but we can't wait for Purim!

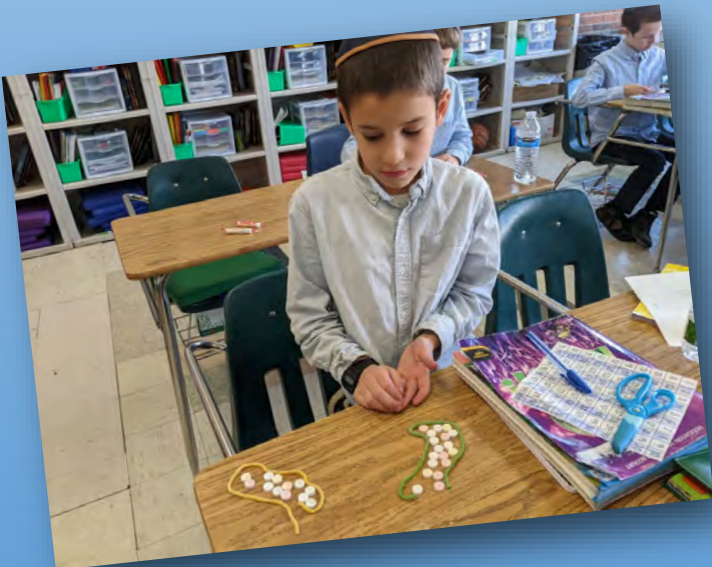

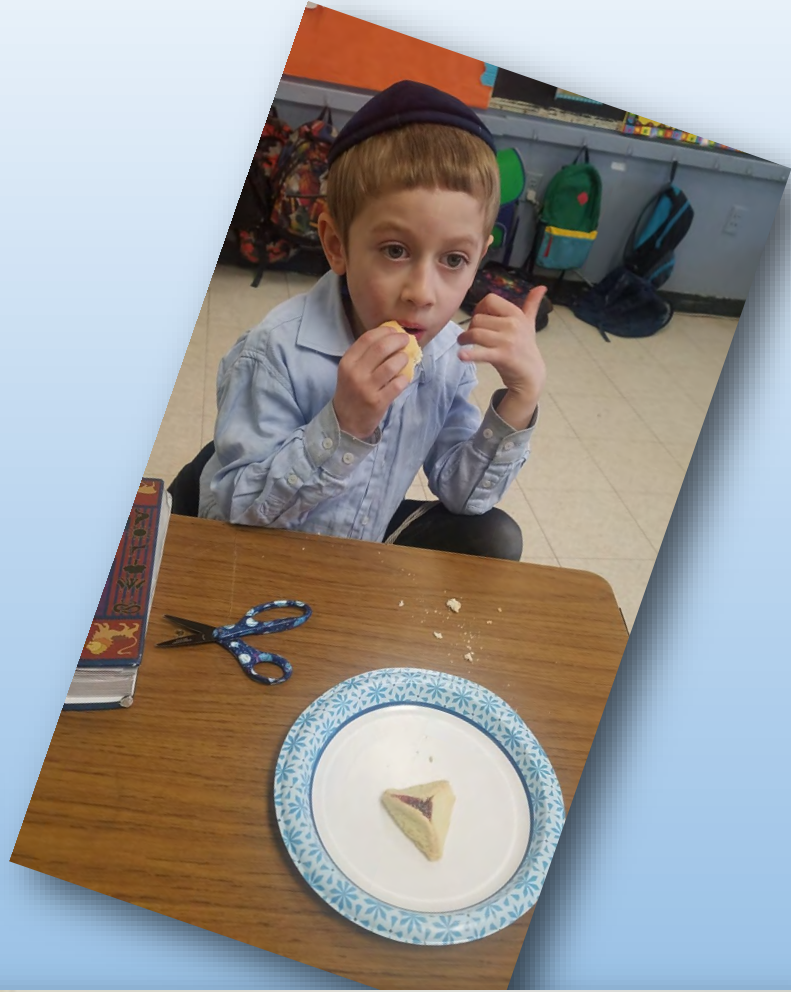
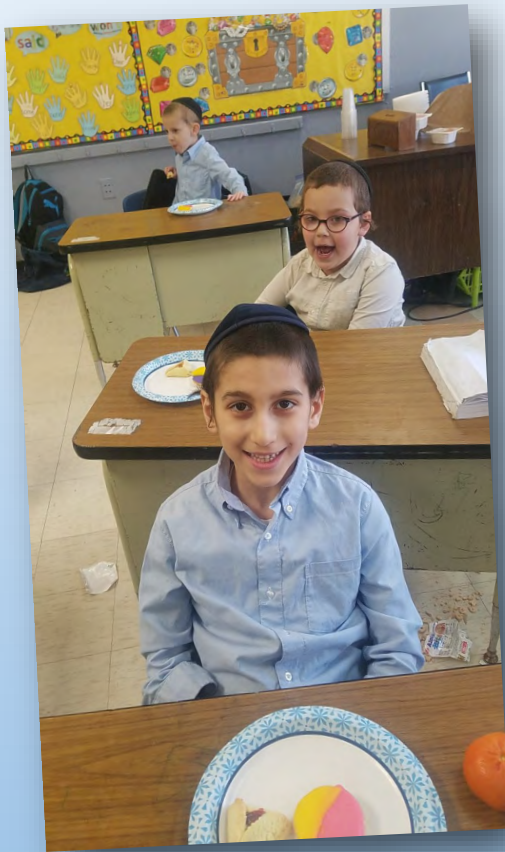
