LETTER FROM THE MENAHEL:

Dear Parents,

This week's parshah speaks about the sin of the *Eigel Hazohov*. It is important to remember that entire story is a detail in the giving of the first and then the second Luchos. The cheit Haegel impacted the Torah itself increasing its breadth and reach.

The 'reset' that the Yidden required after the sin enabled them to receive the Torah once again, allowing them (us) to once again experience Hashem's gift, the Torah.

Today's culture promotes 'happy children' as the desired result of schooling. Another value that has been shared with me is a desire for children to be nice and kind and everything else doesn't matter.

The cheder is a place of learning. There are no shortcuts to gaining skills, which is why every day and every grade are critical. We want our children to be happy so that their ability to learn is improved. All the amenities and qualities that we want to build within our child should be for the expressed goal of improving their relationship to learning.

The Rebbe repeated many times that a talmid's only *avodah* is learning Torah. The primary area of *chinuch* is to teach our children to speak words of Torah. Veshinantom levonecho vedibarto bom. We learn chassidus, we daven and we perform mitzvos carefully to improve our ability to embody what we learn.

Learning how to learn requires patients and diligence. There are no shortcuts. Kria is only the first building block of the many subsequent blocks required to learn how to learn. Our story as a people revolves around learning as we say . גנחנו וצאצאינו וצאצאי עמך ישראל כולנו יודעי שמך ולומדי תורתך לשמה..

Is there anything we can say that would be more powerful than this tefilah?




