LETTER FROM THE MENAHEL:

Dear Parents,

The ancient custom of initiating children into cheder called *areinfirenish, includes* reading the opening *pesukim* of this week's Parshah, Parshas Vayikro. The *chumash* of the *korbonos* opens with *korbonos nedovoh*, voluntary offerings.

In initiating our children to Torah learning and performing mitzvos *behidur*, an important foundation is to introduce them to the idea of doing more than required. Here is one way to look at it: Hashem left some things up to us so that we can show Him what we can do and how special we are from our own initiative. He doesn't have to tell us everything.

I once heard a story from our very own Rabbi Lesches *shlita* about a letter a group of bochurim wrote to the Rebbe when he was a *bochur*. Bochurim wanted to add an additional period to *seder* at night and they asked the Rebbe if this was okay. The Rebbe's responded that there should be a time of day when it is up to the *bochurim* to learn from their own initiative and they should not make an additional *seder*.

What a special lesson! And how beautifully it links with the order of this week's *parshah*.
