PROJECTS AT CHEDER

CHEDER INTIATED

COLLABORATIONS

Projects which an opportunity provided to Cheder as collaboration. We strongly support the project and have some input.

Examples: PTA programs, *Shoneh Halo-chos*, Tzivos Hashem, Mishnah *beyodi* and Connection Point.

Projects in which the Cheder has little to no input and is brought to Cheder due to the strong demand. The Cheder may not agree with every aspect and it may not be the right thing for some students.

Examples: Chidon, Kol HaTorah Kula, Mivtzah Tank Parade, TH Rallies, Chanuka Parade and Ovos Ubonim.
