A PEEK AT OUR WEEK

Dr. Schnitzel came by the second grade to teach the boys how to make SLIME. They added food coloring and watched it change from liquid to a gel like substance. He informed them that glue is made from animal based ingredients, as in horses. Oh my!! In ELA, we introduced the last of the Long E spelled Y, at the end of a word, as in story. Also, the word slowly, with the suffix LY, is an adverb. Our unit on money is "hands on" as the boys use "fake money" to make purchases and figure out their change. B"H it has been quite busy in Grade 3 English Studies. In our math unit we are continuing to learn all about area and perimeter. We are comparing different rectangles and discussing the difference in their area. The boys are enjoying figuring out the area of combined shapes as well. In reading we read an adventure story called "The Cave of the Lost". As we read the story we focused on the reading skill of visualization, and then the boys discussed new endings for the story. In Language Arts this week we learned all about similes. The boys came up with so many great similes! Last week we had an opportunity to have a special art lesson with Mrs. Jacobs. The boys learned techniques to draw Lag Baomer scenes with pastels. The boys did a fabulous job!

The week has sped by as the boys of 4B are flying high with excitement over their studies! ("Spring Fever" may also be a factor...). We have delved deeper into fractions; learning about reducing and lowest common denominators. In Social Studies we are learning about the American Revolution. In Reading we learned about King Midas. 


