First grade is so much fun, we are learning a ton! Now that we learnt all about coin counting we did an activity of "buying" items, the winner got to use the cash bash game. As we continue in math we added and subtracted tens with 2 digit numbers. In our PAF literacy program we explored reading multisyllabic words by dividing each word into VCCV- finding the vowels and dividing the words by the consonants ex. Pic/nic, tun/nel. We enjoyed crafting with yarn for our letter y page. And used paint to dot our sight word cards. In news on the run we read interesting news from all around the world.

Mrs. Mandel - Grade 1

We listened to a Read-Aloud, "The Girl Who Never Made Mistakes". Beatrice was perfect in everyway, until one day she participated in a juggling contest and lost, due to her own mistake. Rather than break down in tears, she decided to laugh and accept what happened. She learned that it is ok to make mistakes and that's why pencils have erasers. We compared how she lived her life before and after this change of attitude. The boys wrote down their own mistakes and what they learned from it. In math, we measured and learned about the customary measurements of inches, feet and yards. To understand the importance of one acceptable system, boys walked across the room and saw that each one had different footsteps based on the size of their foot. Mrs. Sobol enlightened us by sharing what happens with the food we eat as it moves along our digestive system. The boys had many good questions and agreed that we are most blessed and must thank Hashem. Gut Shabbos!
