LETTER FROM THE MENAHEL:

Dear Parents,

Parshas Teruma presents the crowd sourcing efforts for building the *Mishkan*. The Torah tells us that the women came in ahead of the men in donating to the *Mishkan*. The Rebbe brought this instance many times regarding our G-d given *shlichus* to make this world a *Mishkan* for Hashem.

The *posuk* speak of a generosity of heart, נדבת לב. The many comparisons and lessons we can learn from building a physical Mishkan to the work of chinuch, building a spiritual *Mishkan*, are many. We will focus here on the generosity of heart that *chinuch* requires. Being able to give our children our undivided attention requires a generous spirit. When we give our children our full focus, they feel heard, they become calm, feel secure and loved. Our children cannot afford split focus which also leads to us missing something subtle that may be going on for them, which may be where we are needed most.

The 'nedivas lev' in the parshah may have been natural. Nowadays, we may need to emphasize it with greater urgency bringing to attention the extent to which our children need us.

By doing our part along with Hashem's *berochos*, we will merit to experience true *nachas*, in a revealed way from all our children.

This week, we worked on spelling and explored the different meanings of words that sound the same but have different spellings and meanings, such as to, two, and too. It was wonderful to see the students put in so much effort! We played a fun game of "Catch and Spell," where we created sentences as a class while tossing a ball. The students truly enjoyed it, and it reinforced their learning in an engaging way. In Math, we are practicing addition using place value strategies. Some students would benefit from additional review to strengthen their understanding of this important skill. During our map work, several students are improving in their ability to identify locations and understand the use of a com-

pass. Consistent review is key to mastering these concepts. As a bonus, we learned about the Northern Lights and discovered that they are caused by a reaction to Earth's magnetic shield, which protects us from excessive radiation from the sun. The students were fascinated by this scientific phenomenon! Additionally, we reviewed the different systems within society and community using a variety of interactive methods. 




